Dear Friends,

During September and in to October our thoughts are often, in the church, about our harvest festivals, those times when we remember God's gift of provision for us. Of the food we grow, the livestock we rear and all those in the food retail industry who enable it to get to our plates. We respond to that gift by giving food and money to our food bank and community fridge.

By the end of the month you may well be starting to think about the Christmas coming and what gifts you may buy. Those of you with children or grandchildren may already be witnessing the excitement of lists being drawn up for Father Christmas! But giving is not just about what we buy or make or grow, giving is also about what of ourselves we offer to our families, our work and society at large.

The Apostle Peter wrote a letter to, what was then, a small and scattered Christian community around the Mediterranean, urging them to use what gifts God had given them to serve others. He encouraged them to live their lives in the best way they could and in doing so that "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms." (1 Peter 4:10)

As I write this letter in the days following the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, as I watch all the news coverage of her truly remarkable life I am reminded over and again of what a life lived with faith and in the service of others can look like. I am moved to hear His Majesty King Charles III clearly and unequivocally commit his reign to be one of dedicated service also. Standing and supporting people at Sandringham gates in the days following the sad news of the Queen it was clear that her death highlighted our own personal losses. This was combined with thankfulness for the precious treasures we have had in our Queen, family and friends. On **Sunday 30th October** at 4 pm in St Mary's Church, Old Hunstanton we will have our 'Time to Remember' service. A service of quiet reflection, candles to light and a space to remember with thanks anyone we have lost, either recently or in the past. All are welcome and refreshments will be offered afterwards.

Returning to the theme of service, I am aware that none of us has the opportunities granted to their Majesties to serve – but we are all granted some opportunities, in ways small and, maybe occasionally, big to play our part; to give of ourselves in the service of others. Whether we volunteer with an organization, shop for an elderly neighbour, listen to someone in pain and distress or the many, many other ways we give of ourselves, there are opportunities for service everywhere.

And the good news is that we don't have to do it all ourselves. We serve a servant King, a God who gave of himself through Jesus, a God who knows what it is to serve and pours out that love and service on us each and every day. We can all offer our service knowing we do so with God's support and help. As Peter goes on to say: "If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides." (1 Peter 4:11) God is with us every step of the way as we reach out to help those around us.

May God bless you in your service and as you remember our Queen.

THOUGHTFUL TITCHWELL Our group, Stillness on the Saxon Shore, has been meeting in St Mary's, Titchwell on **Friday afternoons** for some eight years now. On most occasions we consider some thoughts on a specific topic that are interspersed with short periods of reflective silence. At other times we have sung the simple chants of worship from the Ecumenical Community at Taize in Burgundy, or celebrated a simple contemplative service of Holy Communion together. More recently, we have introduced a longer, thirty-minute, period of communal silence on the first Friday of the month, introduced by a simple theme to guide those who would like something to lay hold of. Others may prefer to approach God within what an unknown medieval mystic termed "the cloud of unknowing".

We meet at 4 pm for about half an hour. **Friday 7th October** will be our longer period of guided silent prayer. On **Fridays 14th, 21st and 28th October**, we will be considering the parables of Jesus, the great story teller, who always has something to challenge us with.

As stated elsewhere, we were so fortunate to have had the opportunity to celebrate her life in happier circumstances during the Jubilee weekend. Our thoughts are with the Royal Family as they adjust to their new circumstances and commend them on their dignity during what must have been an enormously difficult time.

At our recent Council meeting, the Chair commented on the coming together of residents following the fire in July – the event attended by over 100 people and very worthwhile. There will be a public meeting on **Friday 7th October** at 6.30 pm at Brancaster Staithe and Deepdale

Village Hall to look at the lessons learned from the recent fire, and how we can prepare for emergencies in the future. All are encouraged to attend.

Council agreed to use money obtained through development in the Village (CIL) on a significant repair to the swing at Brancaster Play Area.

We are continuing to work on the planned car parks and yellow lines etc, and are looking at signage to help with traffic issues in the village. There will be further consultation in due course.

Donations were agreed to the two Churches to help with maintenance of the public areas, and we will be writing to the County Council to stress the importance of the mobile library to our residents, at a time when cuts are being considered.



The car scheme will take anyone from our area to any 'medical' appointment (hospital, surgery, opticians, dentist etc) at a cost of 45p per mile.

The scheme is funded by grants and donations. Funding comes from Norfolk County Council, Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk, various Parish Councils and Parish Meetings as well as other organisations. Personal donations are always welcome,

Volunteer Drivers

The scheme urgently needs new drivers. There is no minimum commitment and drivers can say when they are available.

Drivers receive 45p per mile directly from the passenger with a minimum charge of £5.00, at the discretion of the driver. Drivers claim so called 'dead miles', where the driver is travelling to or from a pick-up, each month from BMACCS funds. Again, some drivers choose to donate this to the scheme.

The 45p rate is set by HMRC and this payment does not need to be declared for tax purposes.

Car insurance normally covers car scheme journeys but check with your insurer to be certain. BMACCS can supply a template letter if required.


