Dear Friends,

I remember my first summer living in Brancaster back in 2002. One day in late July I remarked to a friend how quiet the A149 was for the main coast road. "Just you wait until tomorrow", she replied. She didn't like the school holidays. She found the change to her usual peaceful daily life difficult and refused to see anything positive in it. For others the transformation was to be enjoyed. The village came alive with new people to meet, friends welcomed back. For local businesses the influx of visitors is vital. For those visiting it is a time for relaxation, a time to rekindle friendships, to spend quality time with family members, to escape the often over busy daily lives of juggling home, work and family. A time to enjoy open spaces, the sand, the sea and fresh air.

For children and young people it is a time of change as they face perhaps nursery or school for the first time. Moving to a new class, new school, university or going out to work for the first time. Excitement of the new and unknown will be mixed with anticipation and perhaps hesitation. Of course the long August holidays weren't always a time for relaxing. Although they went their separate ways they were both firmly rooted in God's love.

The excitement, the joy, the laughter of both children and adults, making new friends brings pleasure to many. Many who live here spend their holidays here enjoying the beautiful countryside, the beach and visiting those places there is just not enough time to visit during busy everyday lives. However for my friend it may take a little thought on the part of some who come on holiday to turn down the exuberance a little, to respect the privacy of those whose home is here. Where ever you find yourself during August I pray that it will be refreshing and fulfilling.

BRANCASTER PARISH COUNCIL

Council has agreed a new **streetlight maintenance** provider, who will take over the contract in September. If you are reporting a streetlight fault, please do so directly to the Clerk, as all lights in the Parish are maintained by the PC. As with all such reports, it is really helpful to be precise about locations, as so many houses have names not numbers – using the What3Words App on a phone is the simplest way. Regarding who is responsible for issues which may arise, it is best to report **pot-holes, footpath issues, overgrown hedges and signage problems** to Norfolk County Council directly.

Council received three **grant applications** recently. It agreed to fund the School Trip to the Norfolk Show at a cost of £600, gave £4,400 split between the two Churches to help maintain the graveyards/cemetery, and will contribute to National Coastwatch when their funding position is clear after other grant applications. A reminder that Council can give grants to organisations in the Parish which are of general benefit to residents; application details (policy/form) are on the website, and the Clerk is always happy to give advice.

Plans are progressing for an **open "Town Hall" meeting** – this is likely to be on **Saturday 23rd September** in Brancaster Village Hall – please look out for details on boards, website or Facebook in the near future. To help Members of the Public to have **input into Council meetings** more easily, we now have two sessions at the start and end of our meetings – all such meetings are open to the Public, and agendas are published the previous week.

We have been asked about **collecting prescriptions from the Surgery**. Burnham Surgery can deliver prescription medicine to those who are over 70 and infirm and to those with a disability which prevents them from getting to the surgery and have no other means of picking it up. Deliveries to Burnham Deepdale, Brancaster Staithe and Brancaster are on Tuesdays between 9.30 am and 1.30 pm and the recipient must be at home to receive the medicine. Please call the surgery on 01328 737000 to arrange. Those who need to reach the surgery for appointments should use the community car scheme.

Council has agreed to new arrangements regarding the **Chain at Brancaster Staithe Harbour** – the National Trust will be explaining these in detail in coming months with a view to them being in place for next year.

You may be aware that the Scolt Head and District Common Rightholders' Association are engaged in **legal action against Council**. This is ongoing, and therefore we cannot comment further. We will keep you informed when we can refer to the details publicly.

NCI Brancaster were delighted to be chosen as the beneficiaries of the Round the Island Kendal Cup race entry fees held by Brancaster Staithe Sailing Club. Congratulations to race winners Sarah and Bruce! Our thanks to the Commodore and members, and also to the Vice-Commodore for inviting Watchkeepers Richard B and Sarah T to watch the race from the safety boats. NCI Brancaster will also be at the Old Hunstanton Flower Festival on 29th/30th July and would welcome enquiries on the service or any other matter.

Our Water Safety Officer role is now active, and Watchkeeper Henk will be seen out and about in the community and on the beach with our water safety message. We are very grateful to the Norfolk Community Foundation (through the Chiplow Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund) and NCI National Office, who have helped to provide the resources we need to deliver this important message to the community. If there are any local organisations (schools, scout groups, etc) who might be interested in hearing more about this water safety initiative, please contact henk.van.welsen@nci.org.uk. John Allen (Station Manager) represented NCI Brancaster at the prestigious Royal Norfolk Show Community Champions tribute. Watchkeeper Anthony represented NCI Brancaster at a "Paella and Fizz" evening at the Bishop of Norfolk's house.

We remain grateful to the RWNGC for all its assistance, and of course, to our volunteers who help to make Brancaster beach safe for all users.

NEWS FROM THE NATIONAL TRUST

Brancaster Staithe Harbour occupies an important place at the heart of the local community. It's where local residents come together to share in activities they love, catch up with one another, and enjoy the magnificence of this special place. It is also a popular stop-off point for holidaymakers exploring the beautiful North Norfolk coast.

The National Trust is proud to own and look after this special place. We do this by employing a Harbour Master and Assistant Harbour Master to provide safety information, providing navigation buoys and navigation information, and through the ongoing maintenance of the harbour facilities and infrastructure. We also work to safeguard the harbour's long-term future by raising income from things like moorings and launch fees.

If you have visited the harbour recently, you may be aware that we are introducing some changes to how we manage the chain on the hard. Owners of small boats and tenders attached to the chain are being asked to register their craft with us, so we can contact them if there is a problem with their boat. From next year, places on the chain will be subject to a fee and they will be allocated via a public ballot, which will open for entries in August. The ballot will give priority to local people and those with tenders. This is a fairer system than the current first-come, first-served, approach. After several years in which mooring fees have been kept fairly constant, we are also having to adjust these in light of the increased costs of running the harbour. This will allow the continued investment that is needed to keep the harbour safe and well-maintained. As always, if you spot something unusual, call the police on 101, providing as many details as possible, such as descriptions of people and cars, including number plates. But if you believe a crime is in progress, then always dial 999. If you do not wish to leave your details, you can call anonymously, or via Crime Stoppers 0800 555 111; your call is free and confidential.






