#### Dear Friends,

It's that time of year when the pink footed geese fly overhead with their distinctive honking and unique flying pattern called a skein (I've learnt from Google!). It's also the time of year when as the schools return, as I teenager, I always looked forward to the return of Delia Smith on BBC television. I used to like pretending to be her, measuring out all of my ingredients and talking to an imaginary audience. The rule was, I did the mountain of washing up! Now my daughters and I look forward to Bake Off and watch each week as the dishes get more and more complicated and the bakers one by one leave the programme.

We've been picking the abundance of blackberries on our autumn walks and so far have made 17 jars of blackberry jam to donate to various villages fairs. Sadly, homemade jams can't be donated to food banks due to health and safety. We've also created a blackberry blondie, a version of a white chocolate brownie which is rather yummy!

I'm very conscious that this autumn, we are entering a season like no other I've ever lived. The rising cost of fuel, food and living has put many under increased pressure, a pressure like never before. For those of us with a healthy bank balance, we can become immune to the realities of the cost of living for the majority. I understand the hardship and difficulties as I journey with the many who are living hand to mouth. I meet them when I'm out and about, I meet them when I do funerals, I meet them when I do weddings, I meet them when I go to our coffee mornings and harvest services. We live in a beautiful part of the country surround by much wealth, but also poverty which is hidden away. Some have second homes, some even third homes. I ask that as the country face a real winter of discontent and poverty, that those of us who are financially blessed, share our blessings with those who are struggling. #### TITCHWELL REMEMBERS

I suddenly realised how quickly this year has passed as I came to think about Remembrance Sunday. There are six names from the First World War on the memorial in the churchyard, with another from the Second World War still needing to be added for Victor Self. Titchwell's loss of six of its sons over a century ago seems a lot for a small village. However, though there were fewer houses then, I suspect that most of them had more occupants than is the case today. Three generations living together was much more common a century ago and so the population of the village was greater back then. Maybe visit the churchyard sometime during this season and remember before God the men whose names are carved on the memorial, or join us on **Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> November** at 9 am for our short act of remembrance and two minutes silence.

BRANCASTER COUNCIL PARISH NEWS – NOVEMBER 2022 Council was sorry to receive the resignation of Gary Bocking recently – we thank him for his contribution to Council over the last 8 years, including a stint as Vice-Chair last year. We wish him well. By the time this is published we will know whether the vacancy will be filled by election or co-option.

We continue to comment on a large number of planning applications – Brancaster has far more such applications than any other parish in the Borough. We remind residents that we are not the ones who decide, and continually try to ensure that our/your voice is heard, something which is not always made easy!

There was a very good public meeting to discuss the fire in July. A lengthy and detailed report from the fire service was well-received and there was universal thanks expressed to those who had been involved. As yet, no definitive cause has been established.

Council agreed a donation of £200 to the Coastwatch Team who are doing such good work at the Beach.

The Car Park process is moving rapidly. It was agreed to proceed as planned, but, given recent speculation, a joint statement has been prepared:

On September 22<sup>nd</sup> 2022 representatives of Brancaster Parish Council, land partners the Borthwick Family, and their agents Cruso & Wilkin, met. This was to agree the final terms of the licences which will be issued by the Borthwick Family to Brancaster Parish Council for parking at Cockmartin Field in Brancaster Staithe and Cherry Field in Brancaster. Both parties would like everyone to be aware of the following terms of the licences:

- Cockmartin Field will be used only for overflow parking on high Spring tides and is designed for cars with trailers, to get them off the road, when the Hard is flooded. There will be no charges and it will only be open around the Spring tides during the season. It is not intended as a replacement car park for the Hard.
- The Cherry Field will be open each day during the season for those who like to 'park and stride' and to provide parking when the beach road is flooded. There will be a charge attached to parking with a simple system in place to collect payment. Port-a-loos will be provided at this site
- No motor homes or overnight parking will be allowed at either site.

Brancaster Parish Council and the Borthwick Family are pleased to be land partners in this scheme to help improve traffic flow in the villages. Brancaster Parish Council add that the funding for the entire parking plan project including car parks, signs, and traffic restrictions (which is estimated to be in the region of £65,000) is coming from CIL money, grants from NCC, sponsorship from Lynx buses and current savings in the Parish Council Accounts. No extra money will be needed from the precept and the land from our partners, the Borthwick family, is being donated at no charge for a period of two years.

Public meetings are planned by the Brancaster Parking and Safety and all proposals will be posted on the BPC website at brancasterparishcouncil.co.uk.

The next Brancaster Parish Council Meeting will take place on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> November (please note** – the **second** Tuesday of the month) at Brancaster Staithe and Deepdale Village Hall at 6.30 pm. One hour before the meeting revised maps of the proposed parking plans will be available – see below.






