### Dear Friends

With three bank holidays in May I guess this year it really will be the 'merry' month of May. Since Roman times May Day has been a celebration of the arrival of spring and new life. A day when workers would show and sell their crafts and other wares. The May queen would be crowned and maypole dancing would celebrate new life and fertility - if the ribbon didn't break, then good luck would be known throughout the village. In recent years the last Sunday in May has been celebrated as spring bank holiday. Traditionally this bank holiday was the day after Pentecost - a movable feast dependent on the date of Easter. This year the bank holiday does follow the day of Pentecost or Whit Sunday as it used to be known. The disciples of Jesus were gathered together in a locked room for fear of the authorities. Jesus came and stood among them and they received the gift of the Holy Spirit which empowered them to speak of Jesus without fear. Between these two dates the church celebrates Ascension Day when the earthly ministry of Jesus came to an end and he was taken up to rejoin his Father. And of course the third bank holiday on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May, following the great celebration of the coronation of King Charles.

I began by saying the merry month of May. For many these holidays will be a time of celebrating and enjoying times with family and friends. Time to enjoy the beauty of our world and countryside.

For others celebration is not possible. For many the cost of living crisis means life is a constant struggle. Some face repossession of their home, others bereavement, illness, redundancy, divorce, violence within the home or in the community. To celebrate seems impossible. For those of us within the united benefice of Hunstanton and the Saxon Shore we again find ourselves in a period of interregnum. For those unable to accept the ministry of women, or simply women in a position of authority, this may seem a relief. However for many it will leave a gap in the loving pastoral care that both Rachael and Kirsty were able to show to all people they met, not just those who were members of the church. Many have spoken of their sadness and loss they feel as they both leave the benefice. Both Rachael and Kirsty accept that it is right for them to move on and God has guided them to pastures new. Rachael to the Dereham Team Ministry and Kirsty a little further afield to Jersey.

Throughout his ministry we see Jesus showing the love of God to all people. He went out of his way to show that love to those others saw as outcasts, as being unworthy and unlovable. He was to be found talking to women, eating with the tax collector and showing love to the young, the poor and those who were ill. This caused him to be rejected by those in authority and eventually crucified. But God's love does not end. That love was known by the disciples at Pentecost and enabled them to take it to all people.

Many feel at a loss with Rachael and Kirsty leaving. Others feel unable to celebrate the bank holidays. When times are difficult and we feel at a loss it is ok not to feel ok. To look around and reach out, to allow others to minister to us. The disciples reached out and Jesus was there to show them the way. We all need at times to reach out and to be able to assist others or to accept assistance for ourselves. I pray that the celebrations this May will allow all to find light and love.

### SERVICES AND STILLNESS AT TITCHWELL IN MAY

Dear Friends:

We are still in the Easter season and focusing especially on the resurrection of Jesus, and some words of St Paul in his Letter to the Colossians come to my mind about him: "The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation". It is in the character of Jesus that we see the character of God, as well as the example of the perfect human.

The Greek word for an image or picture is *eikon*, from which we get our English word *icon*, and I like to think of Jesus as being the living icon of God. Before the advent of printing and an increase in literacy, churches had many more paintings and icons to teach visually rather than verbally the Christian message, and it is interesting to consider that different pathways in the brain are used for each.

<u>The Stillness Group</u> are going to start looking at icons, of Jesus and other subjects, and how to "read" them on some Friday afternoons at 4 pm, to which you are all welcome to come along. The first Friday of the month consists of a longer period of stillness.

### **BRANCASTER PARISH COUNCIL**

Elections: There are elections for Borough and Parish on 4<sup>th</sup> May. As there were five candidates for the five places for the Staithe Ward, all five have been elected to the Parish Council: Briony Bax, Stephen Bocking, Celia Borthwick, Tom de Winton and Simon Osborn. There will be an election for the five Brancaster seats. Candidates are: Val Carpenter, Chris Cotton, Annalise Dovey, William Gardiner, Tim O'Sullivan and Susie Ullswater. Brancaster Ward voters will be able to vote for up to five of those. In the Borough Council Election the candidates are Tom de Winton and Bob Lawton – all Parish residents have one vote for this election. If you are planning to vote in person, a reminder that you will need to show photographic ID to vote at this year's local elections. More info on all of this on our website and that of the Borough. Polling Station venues will be noted on your voting papers.

<u>Coronation</u> There will be a programme of events over the Coronation weekend across the Parish included elsewhere in this Parish News. Two trees have been planted to mark the event – one at Brancaster Playing Field and one on the Village Green in Brancaster Staithe. Council has granted funding to the Village Halls for the events they are running.

**Planning** We continue to receive a large number of planning applications – more than any similar parish in the Borough. It is worth reminding those who are putting in applications that it can be useful to contact Council before doing so. This can sometimes ease the process; you may be alerted to issues where Council have had reservations. We have agreed a protocol for such occasions – as with all our policies, this is available on the website. Council has also written to the Borough expressing concern over the way infrastructure does not always keep pace with planning approvals.

**Beach Car Park passes** Car Park passes have been issued, though there are one or two more which remain to be processed. Please note any received after 14<sup>th</sup> April will be kept until the next tranche is done, which may be some time.

<u>Other news</u> As the financial year-end has passed, we are in audit season – all figures will be on the website in due course.

It is with regret that the Committee has accepted the resignation of Daphne Potter as our Coordinator due to health reasons BUT we are pleased to say that Linda Craig has taken on this role. Her contact number is 07851 322 580.

Daphne took on the role in 2004 and it is mainly due to her (and the drivers) that the Scheme has been so successful. She was awarded an MBE in the Queen's New Year Honours List 2019 for services to the older people in Norfolk.

Currently we have 14 drivers which often means we, as drivers, undertake at least 2 trips in a day. We desperately need more drivers. You do not have to commit to a day or time. If you are unable to help when contacted, that is quite understood. You are paid 45p per mile by the passengers from their home to the appointment and back, and 45p per mile by the Scheme from your home to the passengers and back (dead miles). We do medically related journeys – GP surgeries, hospitals, dentists, opticians, physio, etc. Please contact Linda if you can help us run this Scheme.


