Dear Friends,

During September and early October our churches will be celebrating harvest. Although most of us have little to do with the growing of crops we still have a deep 'inner sense' to give thanks for the harvest. Our congregations often include those who wouldn't usually attend church services. All are very welcome. Perhaps it is because we know just how important a good harvest is for each of us that we want to rejoice and show our appreciation. But how much thought do we give to how crops are grown and gathered, how our food is produced?

A few days ago a local farmer was making the most of a few dry days. Starting work in the early hours and continuing until at least midnight in an effort to get the crop harvested before the next rain. For us the rain and wind during August may have been annoying, curtailing the way we like to relax with friends and family over the school holidays. For the farmer, crops have been flattened and the yield reduced. Crops need to be gathered in when dry, both for our food and those that make winter food for animals.

Our weather pattern is changing, global warming is affecting many areas of our lives that we may take for granted. Flooding, wild fires, early dry spells which result in seeds not germinating, all affect food production. The responsibility for food production does not just rely on our farmers. We all need to look at our lifestyle and the effect that has on the weather, on global warming and therefore the effect that has on those producing our food.

Another kind of harvest is being celebrated at St Edmunds Church Hunstanton on Sunday 3rd September at 10.45 am. The harvest of 120 years of Christian worship. Following the coming of the railway in 1862 to the seaside town of New Hunstanton, Henry L'Strange had a new church built to service the growing population. St Edmunds was consecrated in 1903. Bishop Jane will be celebrating the Eucharist at this special service. Joining together to celebrate and give thanks is good. Join us at St Edmunds to give thanks to God for this 120 years.

At our harvest festivals we give thanks to God for all the harvest that we have and that we are able to share with others. We look forward to welcoming you.

BRANCASTER PARISH COUNCIL

We can confirm that there will be a "Town Hall" Open Meeting on Saturday 23rd September in Brancaster Village Hall from 2-5 pm. This will be a drop-in session, with refreshments. We will be seeking your views on the full range of things affecting residents – if you are unable to attend, a questionnaire is available (website – Information>Events), or text 07810 775533 if you cannot do online. It will be a chance to meet your new Councillors, and representatives from Community Groups. If you are involved in the latter, please plan on sending a representative to the event - any flyers or leaflets about your work will be most welcome.

A reminder of the **Emergency Planning Meeting** on **Wednesday 6th September** at 6.30 pm in Brancaster Staithe Village Hall. See Civil Emergency Plan below.

<u>Finance</u> - we are pleased to announce that our External Auditor has signed off the 2022/23 accounts with no qualifications. We were asked to look at our allocated reserves, to ensure that we do not hold excess funds, which we will be doing – Council has a healthy balance, and has agreed to put some of this into a new account with better interest rates. A reminder that all our accounts are open and transparent, with a full statement each month provided in the agenda pack for our meetings – available online, along with the full audit paperwork.

<u>Planning applications</u> We considered a large number most of which did not produce objections, though one – a plan for up to seven dwellings in Town Lane, Brancaster Staithe - will be called in to the Planning Committee by our Borough Councillor for more detailed consideration. We can only object to applications on valid "material" considerations – there is a detailed explanation of this on the new website.

One of these applications was the **Boardwalk** – this ongoing process has now reached the planning stage, and, if agreed, should be going ahead soon. We are also chasing Anglian Water with the hope of a meeting to look at concerns over the infrastructure required in our growing Parish. Council is a member of the Saxon Shore group of Parishes, which will be seeking a meeting with them.

Two circular **benches** have been agreed to go round the Coronation Trees, and a range of small maintenance projects was confirmed.

Regular readers will be aware that Council has the power to provide **grants** to local groups – we have now agreed that these will be considered at our June and November meetings. Application details (policy/form) are on the website, and the Clerk is always happy to give advice.






