Dear Friends,

November is a month for remembering. The 1st is All Saints Day when we remember those people who have been like saints to us. Each generation has people who inspire others. Perhaps with their determination in times of personal difficulty - I think of Dame Deborah James or Tony Hudgell. Or perhaps those who speak out against injustice even when it puts their own lives at risk. Perhaps we think of people in our own families or communities who have gone that one step further to show love, justice and peace to others. The 2nd November is All Souls day when we remember loved ones who have died. In our churches on 5th November we celebrate All Saints. Of course 5th November is also the day when Guy Fawkes' failed gunpowder plot is remembered.

For many Remembrance Sunday - this year on the 12th - is the main day for remembering in November. The day when we give thanks for all those who have given their lives so we may live in peace. Particularly the first and second world wars, but also the many conflicts that have happened since then and the many that are continuing today. The chorus of the song "Where have all the flowers gone" comes to my mind. And yes I know this dates me as it was written 60 years ago in 1962 by Peter Seeger. The chorus is "When will they ever learn, when will they ever learn". It's a song written at the time of heightened awareness of the threat of nuclear war during the 1950s and 60s. It also speaks of the sadness and frustration that one generation to the next continues to repeat the fruitlessness of war. The word "they" has been changed to we or you by different singers. And the question still remains - when will they, we, me or you ever learn. When we will stop asking our young men and women to leave their families and homes and go to war. Perhaps this is more poignant for those of us with close family and friends serving in the military today. Perhaps with the awful pictures on our television screens and in newspapers it brings home to us how easily our lives can be shattered. How do we, can we, answer the question "when will they, we ever learn". Perhaps if we look at the life and example of Jesus we can see a way to "learn" - Jesus challenged by his teaching and actions the traditional standards and roles within society whenever these prevented the love, justice, peace of God from being experienced by all people.

There is a service for Remembrance Sunday at each of our churches. Join us to give thanks for those who have made the ultimate sacrifice.

May the peace and love of Christ be with each one of us.

BRANCASTER PARISH COUNCIL

Our Big Community Chat produced a range of issues which we will be considering in coming months, including youth facilities (possible club, and Brancaster Staithe play area), and improved information (including access to external sources such as housing provision). This followed breakout groups discussing housing/development, facilities/ amenities, roads/parking. Those attending were given information on which authorities deal with which issues – this is often not easy to establish. This and other data will be added to our website in the near future.

We again considered a large number of planning applications, with mixed responses, some based on our Neighbourhood Plan. You will be aware that there has been discussion locally about restricting second/holiday homes. When our Plan was first developed, and then revised, there was little pressure for such provisions. Should this change, a further revision would be required; this would need a lengthy period of research and planning by a group of the public and Councillors, before another referendum. Council has made no plans to proceed along these lines.

As the weather is turning colder please be aware that there are many schemes to help householders – renters and owners - with insulation, sometimes free of charge. 
