#### Dear Friends,

Love, joy and peace are words which are often used to describe Christmas. They are found in Christmas cards, on wrapping paper, and sung in carols and secular songs. For many of us Christmas is a time to look forward to. A time to see family and friends, to renew old acquaintances. A day of anticipation of fun and enjoyment. All the preparation is finished and it's time to relax. But what for those who are unable to join in the celebrations? For many the cost of living crisis means a lack of food and warmth. Some face redundancy, homelessness and increasing debt. Many are alone. In many parts of the world people face war and live in constant fear. Natural disasters are faced by many because of global warming.

Christmas is the celebration of the birth of Jesus. The only room his parents could find was a stable surrounded by animals and hay. They were away from home, family and friends. They certainly were not expecting any visitors. Yet almost as soon as Jesus was born they were visited by shepherds. Shepherds were poor men who many regarded as the 'lowest of the low'. They were doing a job which no one else wanted. Yet these were the first to be informed of the birth of Jesus, his first visitors. The second group of people to visit were men or magi. They were wealthy, powerful, intellectual men from the East, they were not of the Jewish faith. They had spent years studying astrology, hoping to find a king who would save the world.

Eventually their time was rewarded by the sign of a star. But they didn't find a baby in a palace surrounded by wealth. They found a homeless baby in a poor stable among the cattle.

His father was a carpenter. Carpenters were despised as outcast and unclean because they made coffins and touched dead bodies. Hardly the setting for a king. Jesus was born to welcome and to reconcile all people, rich and poor, those of different cultures and nationalities. Throughout his life we see a God of love, joy and peace. Through his life Jesus taught us how to treat all people with love, and respect so that all may live lives knowing love, joy and peace.

It is good to celebrate, to share love, joy and peace with family and friends, to re-charge exhausted batteries. As we do this with our families and friends can we also share that love, joy and peace with those whose own lives are unable to reflect this? It is the love with which presents are given that makes a difference, not the size or cost. Giving fair trade food and gifts and those which help sustain the world's resources, or buying from charity shops, will help others to know that love, joy and peace of Christmas.

May the love, joy and peace of Christ be with us all this Christmas and New Year.

As well as undertaking watches on Brancaster beach, the service will continue to concentrate on its message of water safety with community groups and schools, as this remains a high priority. To this end it will have a table at the Brancaster Winter Fair on **Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> November**, so do please come along and meet members of the team from 10 am to 3 pm.

#### **BRANCASTER PARISH COUNCIL**

At our November meeting a wide range of things were discussed and agreed. The Borough is conducting a review of Polling Districts, and are proposing no changes. Council agreed not to request any changes either.

We agreed to donate £2,000 to the Robert Smith Trust, to help with insulation on three of their Almshouses. We are working with them to see if we can obtain funding from other sources – surprisingly, given the grants that are available, this seems problematical with regards to funding housing charities....

As ever, we considered a number of Planning Applications. It is worth a reminder that, should there be applications which arrive between meetings, we do sometimes have extra Planning sessions by Zoom (to help the Clerk form a response). These are timetabled on the website, but only take place when there are sufficient applications to make them worthwhile; they are open to the Public, and have agendas as with all our meetings, which are published in advance.

It was noted that the seats around the Coronation Trees are now in place, and look very fine. The 80<sup>th</sup>Anniversary of D-Day next year will be commemorated, with events and a Beacon. If you are interested in being involved, either individually or as a group, please contact Cllr Briony Bax at cllr.briony.bax@brancaster-pc.gov.uk

Councillors had met with the National Trust, and it was confirmed that there will be no charge to residents for a place on the Chain at Staithe Harbour. A revised Memorandum of Understanding was agreed for the management of the Village Green there.

There was mention of the meeting at Hunstanton about the proposed Wash Barrier. It was generally agreed that this was not as informative as it might have been about the proposals – they are barely more advanced than when it was first advertised several months back. Most of the infrastructure will be on the Lincolnshire side, with the full barrier apparently being something of an "optional extra". Clearly, Council cannot make any decision on its views until there are more concrete plans – we will, as ever, keep you informed.

It was suggested that we form a group of volunteers in the village willing to help out with painting, mending and other works. If you are handy and could donate some time and sweat this winter please get in touch with the Clerk.

Council will again be placing Christmas Trees at the village greens in Brancaster and Brancaster Staithe for your enjoyment. This year we will be trying solar lights.

After the Big Chat councillors will be compiling results of the survey and we will be sharing that with you. One point that came up was the need for a Youth Group in our villages. If you are interested in helping form a one night a week activity for the young people in our Parish, please email <a href="mailto:cllr.briony.bax@brancaster-pc.gov.uk">cllr.briony.bax@brancaster-pc.gov.uk</a>. We are also becoming a Lead Council for the Norfolk Falls project – this to help those who fall, and to try and avoid lengthy waits for an ambulance – again there is a need for volunteers. There is a lot more information on this on our website – News page.

Our final meeting of the year will be on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December** in Brancaster Village Hall at 6.30 pm. Our **January** meeting is on **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup>** in Brancaster Staithe Village Hall. As usual the agenda and relevant papers will be on the website prior to the meetings.






