September sees another change in seasons as we move from summer to autumn. The long school holiday is over, children and young people are back at school, university or beginning paid work for the first time. Our villages are quieter as holiday makers return home. Some are able to take change in their stride, others find it more difficult. Some long for things to continue as they have always been, others can't wait for new experiences. Perhaps one section of society whom we may give little thought to are our farmers who continually face change. Those men and women whom we rely on to bring us food throughout the year whatever the season may bring. And this is another area of change - I remember when a change in seasons brought a change in food available. Fresh spring vegetables, summer fruits, autumn berries and winter would bring root vegetables. Now we expect all kinds of food to be available all year. This year the very wet spring washed away many of the early seedlings, resulting in low yields. Farmers have had to plant again in the hope that better weather will result in a later crop. The seasons' weather is also changing. With more extreme weather, rain, storms, floods, heat waves, all bring uncertainty and stress for our farmers as they continue to struggle with the changes in our weather. Throughout August farmers have been harvesting. Do we simply expect food to be available regardless of the changing seasons or are we able to give thought to how it is produced both here and further afield? Are we able to look at how our way of life may affect the changes in weather with global warming, rising sea temperatures which affect sea life, melting of the ice cap bringing flooding to low lying lands and with many living along our Norfolk coast facing loss of land and homes to the sea. Change is not easy but do we not owe it to those who produce our food to think of the consequences our way of life may have. Each of our churches celebrates harvest during September or October - see the calendar of services overleaf. Join us to give thanks for harvest and the blessing that God continues to give.

September ends with the churches celebrating on the 29th: St Michael and All Angels. There are three angels mentioned in the bible - Michael which means 'who is like God' and described as the protector of Israel and perhaps best known as the slayer of the dragon in the book of Revelation of John. Gabriel which means the 'strength of God' who according to the gospel of Luke announces the birth of Christ, and Raphael which means 'the healing of God' and is depicted in the book of Tobit as restoring the sight to Tobit's eyes. In the fifth century a basilica near Rome was dedicated in honour of Michael on 30th September with celebrations beginning on the eve of that day. September 29th is now kept in honour of St Michael and All Angels throughout the western church. We are holding a benefice service at Ringstead Church at 10.00 am on **Sunday 29th September**. Come and join us as we celebrate harvest in its widest sense - harvest of food, our changing world, those who protect, those who heal and those who bring good news.

ST MARY'S, TITCHWELL

Our readings in church have recently been from the sixth Chapter of the gospel of John. They tell the story of the "Feeding of the Five Thousand", when Jesus had compassion on a hungry crowd who had enthusiastically followed him into the middle of nowhere, after he had tried to get away for some free time with his disciples.

God had fed the people of Israel in the desert with the manna through Moses; He had called all those people out of Egypt into the desert of Sinai so He was responsible for them. And likewise, God in Jesus Christ was responsible for feeding the hungry crowd on that Galilean hillside by miraculously multiplying five loaves and two fish. But there's more to life than just the food that keeps our bodies going. We need to feed our souls; we need to feed the spiritual part of us. And Jesus is the one to do it. He said to that hungry crowd, "I am the bread of life". Like that crowd, we need to come to Jesus, but finding time for him, without the distraction of our busy lives: find time to pray to him, and read about him in our bibles. We often put things into different boxes. Jesus never did. When he ate to feed his body, he remembered God each time and gave thanks to his Father in Heaven, probably saying something like this modern Jewish prayer over bread: "Blessed are you, Lord our God, ruler of the universe, who brings forth bread from the earth." It's good to remember to put God first in all we do, and then we will be more likely to be doing it for the right reasons.
