Autumn, the season when nature prepares for winter and surrounds us with a wonderful display. The leaves on trees and hedges turn a magnificent autumnal colour: from gold, orange, red, yellows and all shades in-between. Even the berries on the trees and hedges seem to be a brighter colour, red, yellow orange and of course the black of blackberries. Perhaps this brightness allows birds to see them more clearly as they need to store fat before winter sets in. The fruits and nuts from the trees fall to the ground allowing squirrels and other animals to feed on them or store them for winter. When the leaves fall we can hear the excited laughter of children as they spend time kicking and shuffling through them. Hedgehogs and other small creatures can use these fallen leaves to provide shelter and warmth during the winter months. It would seem that left to its own resources little in nature is wasted and it is completely free for us to wonder at and enjoy. We may need an extra layer of clothing to spend time outside but it is well worth the small effort to wrap up and take a quiet stroll observing the beauty around us. To walk along the beach or cliff top, perhaps sitting in one of the cliff top shelters or finding a sheltered spot in the sand dunes to just observe the wonders of nature around us. For those unable to get outside, to sit beside a window just for a short while to clear our minds of the hustle and bustle of everyday life. Just to be aware of our footsteps and the noise they make as we walk, or to be aware of our breathing as we sit. Maybe to fix our gaze on a particular flower, tree or leaf. To give thought as to how it has got to the point where it is now, the journey that it has gone through. How did the seed from which it grew get into the ground, what did it need to grow and get to its present state. What will its next stage be. Are there new seeds or buds waiting to begin life? Will it provide food, nutrients or shelter for other life. Are there ways which we can help that cycle of life, maybe by not clearing away dead leaves but leaving them in a pile in a corner. Not throwing away dead twigs or small fallen branches, but leaving them in a pile for insects to live in. Setting aside just a short time each day if possible, or each week, to contemplate on nature can really help our mental wellbeing. In turn this will help us in our daily busy lives.

Jesus knew the importance of spending time away from the crowds, finding time and space for himself. With the wonders of nature in autumn this is the perfect time for us also to begin to find space for ourselves.

#### ST MARY'S, TITCHWELL

Autumn is now truly upon us with the shortening days, and the need to wrap up warmly. It is also the season for Harvest Festivals and, when planning services, I find no shortage of texts to use from the gospels. Jesus grew up and lived his life in the rural backwater of Galilee, far from the bustle and theological controversy of the big city, Jerusalem.

We can sense his evident delight in the natural world and the agricultural practices of his day in so many of his parables.

Remember those well-known words of his, "Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: and yet I say unto you, that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these." He said this to tell us not to worry too much about the things of this life, but to put God first. For Jesus had a strong and lively sense of the goodness and fatherhood of God. His spirituality was not that of escaping from the world, but going out and enjoying it all.

We read how he was often going up mountainsides for solitude in prayer, but it is very obvious that he also greatly enjoyed the good food and company of others around the meal table.

He lived in the present, celebrating the goodness of God - and he is still urging us to do the same. With this in mind, the Harvest Celebration and Thanksgiving at St Mary's, Titchwell this year will be on **Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> October** at 10.30 am. There will then be a Harvest Lunch in the marquee at 12.30 pm. Tickets for a ploughman's meal and dessert are £15 a head and can be obtained from Susan our church warden (Tel 01485 210756). #### **BRANCASTER PARISH COUNCIL**

It is worth a reminder that the PC website contains a wealth of information about the Parish, and this includes a "Who does what?" section under "Services". This answers many of the questions about which authority to contact about drainage, hedges, etc. This may avoid delays, and can keep you up to date on progress. Please do let us know if you have any thoughts on the website – especially errors/broken links etc – as it is intended to be a useful and accurate resource. Another useful resource relates to what goes in what bin – the Borough does all it can to encourage recycling, but there are often problems with people not being fully aware of the restrictions. Tennis week seemed to go off without too many problems – thanks to all those involved. Issues with the rough sleeper continue, but the PC has done all it can, and presses other authorities when possible.

We have installed bike racks at the two Village Halls, which were funded by a Borough Council grant. One remains to be fitted, and we are working with the National Trust on this. We congratulate Brancaster Staithe/Burnham Deepdale Village Hall on their splendid new Play Area, and encourage you to donate via their "gofundme" page to help with Phase II. (See below)

We continue to have a large number of Planning Applications – a reminder that when these fall between our normal meetings, we have virtual sessions to ensure we comment in time – these are linked from the website. The Borough is consulting on its Local Plan -

This is a complicated area but is open to all for comment. Council requests that if you do write to them, that you copy us in. At our previous meeting we agreed a donation of £3,000 to the local First Responders' scheme – this will help with the provision of local First Aid and other health assistance, particularly when there are ambulance delays.

Finally, you may have seen elsewhere that a settlement agreement has been made with the Scolt Head and District Common Rightholders' Association following their withdrawal from the case relating to income from the Beach Car Park at Brancaster. Council is very pleased that this long process has concluded and the donations from the Golf Club can continue to be used for the benefit of all parishioners and local groups. An elderly person was reported swept away by the very strong current flowing into the channel by Scolt Head Island; the emergency services were called out and deployed a lifeboat, hovercraft and helicopter. The person was recovered in Brancaster Staithe harbour but had, very sadly, not survived. Our thoughts go out to the family facing this tragedy.

The other incident involved someone stranded by the incoming tide on a sandbank near Titchwell; once again emergency services responded but, fortunately, the individual involved was able to wade to safety. Both these incidents highlight the potential dangers of currents and tides off the beaches, and the vital importance of swift action by Brancaster Coastwatch when emergencies arise.

On a lighter and very positive note, the Hunstanton Tennis Week raised £1400 for NCI Brancaster, and we thank the organisers for their most generous support. Further, the NCI took part in the Emergency Services day at Hunstanton and the Brancaster Staithe Sea Shanty Festival in September. Our congratulations go to John A, NCI Brancaster Station Manager, who has received his five-year award for loyal service. Each time the scammers pretended to be police officers. Please remember that no police officer or bank official will ever ask you to withdraw money. Do share this advice with anyone who may be vulnerable to scams, particularly friends and family who may not be online or are less tech-savvy. 


